Makerspace Studio Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Where is Makerspace Studio located?

Makerspace Studio is located on the 2nd floor of the building (the top floor), within the Westfall Children's Program Room. Turn right as you exit the stairs or elevator. The entrance is down the hall on the left.

When is Makerspace Studio open?

Makerspace Studio currently has a limited schedule that offers a mix of dropin hours and appointments. Visit <u>barringtonlibrary.org/makerspace</u> for current availability.

During drop-in hours, patrons are free to use and learn about Makerspace Studio equipment, no appointment necessary.

One-hour appointments are available throughout the week, as well. To book an appointment, use our <u>online booking form</u>.
