Access From a Web Browser



STEP 1

Access eZone at ezone.oslri.net

STEP 2

Click on "Sign In" and login with your library card number and PIN.

STEP 3

Search for a title or author or browse some of the curated lists on the eZone homepage

STEP 4

If a title is available, click "Borrow" and then select your loan period. Then select how you would like to read your item (Kindle, EPUB, or in-browser). You can find your loans on your Bookshelf denoted by this icon:

STEP 6

If a title has a wait list, you can click "Place a Hold" and have your name added to the hold list.

 Note: Enter a valid email address to be notified when your hold becomes available to download.

Important Things to Know

Loans

- Borrow up to 8 titles per card
- No overdue or late fees

Holds

- Place up to 4 holds per card
- You have **3** days to borrow an item before it is passed on to the next person in line

Wish List

- Add items you want to check out in the future to your Wish List
- Find your Wish List under "My Account"

Return & Renew

Returns

Titles automatically expire and are removed from your device unless you return them early or renew

Return a title early:

- From Desktop/Browser: go to "My Account" and select "Loans." Select "Return" below the item you wish to return.
- From Libby App: go to your "Loans" and tap "Manage Loan" next to title you want to return. Tap "Return Early."
- From Amazon: go to "Manage my Content and Devices" and locate the item you want to return. Tap on the title and select "Return."

Renew

Renew option will become available when you have **3** days left of your loan.

 <u>Note</u>: Not all items will be available to renew. If another patron is in line for a title you have checked out you will not be able to renew.

Check under "My Account" > "Loans" to see if your item is available to renew. You will need to redownload the item to Libby or your Kindle.

STEP 1 Download Libby from App Store (Apple) or Play Store (Android) Search for "Libby"

STEP 2

Open the Libby app and say "Yes I have a library card"

- Select "I'll search for a library"
- Enter "Barrington Public Library" and select "Ocean State Libraries eZone"
- Tap "Enter Library account details"
- Sign in with your library card number and PIN then tap "Next"

STEP 3

Use the navigation bar on the bottom of the screen

- \bigcirc Search for books
- Explore eZone digital collection
- Library card, settings, & notifications
- View shelf loans, holds, & tags
- Timeline (history)



STEP 4

Read, watch, or listen to loans right in Libby app or send ebooks to your Kindle device. When borrowing, select your loan period (**7**, **14**, or **21** days).

For Kindle eReaders only!

Kindle Fire Devices can follow Libby app procedures.

STEP 1

Use a computer, tablet, or smartphone to open eZone (via website or Libby app)

STEP 2

On eZone website, use the search filters to find and borrow an ebook that is available to download on Kindle. Not all ebooks are easily available on Kindle.

STEP 3

From your Loans page, select "Read now with Kindle" and you will be taken to Amazon's website to complete your checkout.

You will need to login to the Amazon account your Kindle device is registered under.

STEP 4

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Follow the on-screen prompts to "Get library book" and wirelessly deliver it to your Kindle device.

Get Library Book

NOTE

Kindle eReaders require a Wi-Fi connection to download and sync library Kindle books from Amazon. If you don't have a Wi-Fi connection, you can transfer the Kindle book to your device via USB.
